Southeastern also offers many scholarships on behalf of generous donors from the Southeastern district as a way to encourage students in their academic endeavors. This packet includes the application and information regarding each program, performance, ambassador and foundation scholarship.

To apply for scholarships, applicants must:

1. Print and complete the application.
2. Complete a typed 750-1,000 word essay explaining career goals, leadership experience, community involvement and need for the scholarship.
3. Submit high school or current college unofficial transcript.

*Additional information, such as portfolio or other documentation, may be requested for performance scholarships. Please see the contact person listed on the performance scholarship page of the application. Performance scholarship deadline is February 28; however, applications may be accepted until all scholarships are awarded.

Program and Foundation applications must be postmarked no later than **February 28**, with the exception of Nursing and Allied Health and Student Ambassador applications, which must be postmarked no later than **March 31**.

General Information**Eligibility Requirements**

All scholarship recipients must be continuously enrolled in at least 12 credit hours for both Fall and Spring semesters. To remain eligible for subsequent semesters, students must successfully complete a minimum of 12 hours with a GPA of 2.5 or above (unless otherwise indicated in scholarship agreement). Program Scholarship recipients must complete a one credit hour volunteer course each semester. This course, SERV 121 Service Learning, consists of providing 32 hours of volunteer work each semester during both fall and spring semesters within the department awarding the scholarship. Failure to meet the minimum requirements determined by each scholarship may result in termination of scholarship. All recipients are required to major in the program area for which the scholarship is awarded. In addition, scholarship recipients are required to participate in extracurricular activities for their respective program area. All institutional scholarship recipients must have a FAFSA on file.

Programmatic Scholarship Maximum Annual Value and Benefits

The maximum value of each scholarship is sixteen (16) credit hours of in-district tuition only, unless stated otherwise. Funds will be disbursed on a schedule of eight (8) credit hours of in-district tuition only for the Fall semester and eight (8) credit hours of in-district tuition only for the Spring semester. Unused scholarship money cannot be transferred to the next semester. Scholarship benefits are limited to tuition. The total amount may not exceed 8 credit hours of in-district tuition per semester.

Performance Scholarships

To apply for one of the scholarships below, you must contact the faculty member or supervisor listed below.

❖ **Art**

Students are required to have a minimum 3.0 GPA on 4.0 scale, or 4.0 GPA on 5.0 scale for eligibility. In addition to the application and essay, applicants may choose to submit a letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, participate in a personal interview, and provide a portfolio of a minimum 10 pieces displaying skills and artisanship in a variety of media, knowledge or formal concerns of design and composition, and development of ideas demonstrating originality. Art scholarship recipients are required to maintain a 3.0 grade point average to maintain continued eligibility of the scholarship, participate in weekly studio hours, and enroll in selected art courses.

❖ **Speech Team**

Music scholarships are based on academic standing, musical ability, letters of recommendations, and an individual audition with the music director (set by appointment). Music scholarship students are expected to participate in all musical productions and activities. Students are not required to major in music; however, they must be enrolled in music theory courses, private lessons, and an ensemble in order to stay on scholarship.

Performance Scholarship Maximum Annual Value and Benefits

The maximum value of a Performance Scholarship is nineteen (19) credit hours of in-district tuition only, unless stated otherwise. Scholarship balances remaining after the end of the semester or academic year are not refundable or transferable.

Student Ambassador Scholarships

Student Ambassador Scholarships are awarded annually to five graduating seniors and five college freshmen. Individuals selected to be Ambassadors will serve as liaisons for the College at their home high school, community events, special college events, parades, and college recruitment activities. This list is not inclusive of all possible activities. **Applicants must complete an Ambassador Scholarship form in addition to the general Southeastern scholarship application.** If chosen, applicants will be contacted for an interview.

Student Ambassador Scholarship Maximum Annual Value and Benefits

The maximum value of each scholarship is sixteen (16) credit hours of in-district tuition only, unless stated otherwise. Funds will be disbursed on a schedule of eight (8) credit hours of in-district tuition only for the Fall semester and eight (8) credit hours of in-district tuition only for the Spring semester. Unused scholarship money cannot be transferred to the next semester. Scholarship benefits are limited to tuition. The total amount may not exceed 8 credit hours of in-district tuition per semester.

A scholarship will be awarded to a female student majoring in computer science.

❖ **DENNIS ALLEN SPEECH SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship is awarded to a sophomore with a concentration in the humanities division.

❖ **HAROLD BAUMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled full-time with financial need and demonstrating above average academic standards.

❖ **DOROTHY HELEN BALDWIN HARRISBURG BUSINESS & PROFESSIONAL WOMEN'S SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship award that recognizes excellence among business students. Qualifications include demonstrating above average academic standards, a strong devotion to the field of business, and a desire to succeed.

❖ **RUTH BAIRD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship awarded based on academic performance and financial need.

❖ **JOHN BENNEWITZ/JULIE FOWLER ORANGE MEMORIAL ART SCHOLARSHIPS**

A scholarship is awarded to a student with an interest in art who demonstrates high academic standards.

❖ **EDWARD A. BRADLEY, SR MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship will be awarded to recognize scholastic achievement and outstanding leadership, attributes Mr. Bradley felt were of great value.

❖ **RODNEY J. BRENNER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship is awarded to a Pope County High School student who must exhibit and maintain high academic standards and display outstanding qualities of citizenship.

❖ **ALLEN BRICKHAUS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship will be awarded to an incoming freshman who is a recent graduate of Pope County or Massac County High School. This student must be majoring in education, must have a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale, as well as demonstrate characteristics of good citizenship.

- ❖ **GLADYS AND RAYMOND CARROLL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a sophomore enrolled full time with a minimum of 24 credit hours completed at Southeastern Illinois College. The student must be in good academic standing and maintain a 3.0 average.
- ❖ **COMPANION PET RESCUE SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded during the second semester of the recipient's first year. Student must be involved in a field of study with focus on animal welfare or environmental preservation.
- ❖ **MARGARET CONLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is awarded to a student who is a Hardin County High School student or Hardin County resident and have financial need and average academic achievement.
- ❖ **GEORGE COX MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled full-time in an associate in applied science degree or certificate program in Automotive Technology or Diesel Technology.
- ❖ **JOHN & AUDREY COYLE SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is awarded to a full-time student at Southeastern with at least a B average in high school who has demonstrated a propensity for academic success. The student must be a graduate of a high school in SIC's district, with first priority to Gallatin and Saline counties. Priority preference given to nursing and education majors, with engineering majors given secondary consideration.
- ❖ **DELTA SHRINE CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**
The scholarship is available to a Hardin County High School graduate who must have completed a minimum of 30 credit hours at SIC and be of sophomore standing.
- ❖ **MADLINE DEMPSEY ALLIED HEALTH SCHOLARSHIP**
A monetary award to be given to a student enrolled in the Health Occupations Program.
- ❖ **GEORGE T. DENNIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
The recipient shall have a concentration in humanities and be an enrolled sophomore with high academic standards.
- ❖ **DIEFENBACH FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP**
The scholarship will be awarded to a Saline county graduate with a financial need and above average academic standards.
- ❖ **JOHN B. DOTSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled full-time with a financial need and high academic achievement.
- ❖ **JARRELL EASLEY (FFA) MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is awarded to a student with a membership and active participation in a high school FFA program.
- ❖ **JESSE & MARY EDWARDS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is awarded to a student with the criteria of academic performance, financial need, and preference given to residents of White County.

- ❖ **ELDORADO JUNIOR WOMEN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a student who graduated from Eldorado High School that is a sophomore graduating in May, and plans to transfer to a four-year college or university.
- ❖ **EWING-ZUMWALT SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is awarded to an incoming freshman, enrolled fulltime at Southeastern Illinois College, majoring in Allied Health/Nursing, Math/Science, or a Business Program. This student must have a 3.0-4.0 GPA, must be a United States citizen, and reside in the Southeastern Illinois College District.
- ❖ **MATTHEW J. FRY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is awarded to a full-time student who is in a Business related degree program, A.A.S. or A.S, a Sophomore student graduating from Southeastern Illinois College in the spring, resides in the five- county college district, have a C grade point average or higher, and demonstrates financial need.
- ❖ **JAYLYNN FERRELL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a student who is accepted and enrolled as an ADN nursing student at Southeastern Illinois College the first year, accepted and enrolled in ADN or LPN nursing Sophomore year, registered as full-time at Southeastern Illinois College, has good academic standing, is dedicated to a nursing profession and patient care, is a United State citizen, has financial need, but not required, and is a resident of the Southeastern Illinois College district.
- ❖ **JOAN FERRELL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
Scholarship to be awarded to an applicant from the district, enrolled full time, with an interest in English Education and demonstration of high academic performance.
- ❖ **C. R. GARDNER**
A scholarship awarded based on academic performance and financial need.
- ❖ **EVA GERSBACHER SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a student with an interest in biology and excellent academic performance.
- ❖ **PAUL HALBERSLEBEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship awarded based on academic performance and financial need.
- ❖ **CHUCK HEARN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a recent graduate of Carrier Mills High School, who is a member of the rifle team, the archery team, or a nursing student, who will be attending Southeastern Illinois College in the fall. If no one is available from Carrier Mills it may go to a Harrisburg student.
- ❖ **MICHAEL HILLEGAS CHAPTER D.A.R. SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a graduate from Gallatin County High School, Hardin County High School, or any Saline County High School (Carrier Mills-Stonefort, Eldorado, Galatia, Harrisburg). The student shall be a freshman enrolled full time and fulfilling the requirements of a first year to be considered for this scholarship. To receive the scholarship funds, the student shall be enrolled for the following year full time with enough acquired credits to be classified as a

sophomore. The student must also have at least an overall B average or better.

- ❖ **ROCK HITES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a first-year student in a vocational/technical program and demonstrate a commitment to a career in natural resource conservation.
- ❖ **MAXINE THERESA HOBBS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
The applicant is to be enrolled in the RN program and a graduate of Hardin County High School. The scholarship is based on high academic performance.
- ❖ **GENE HUMPHREY SCHOLARSHIP IN MEMORY OF HUGHIE E. HUMPHREY**
A scholarship will be awarded to a student who graduated from a high school in the district, who has a minimum GPA average of a B, who is enrolled full-time at SIC, who demonstrates the characteristics of good citizenship, and they must be majoring in a Science/Technology/Engineering/Math (STEM) discipline.
- ❖ **DR. MICHAELIS B. JACKSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a first year student enrolled in the nursing program. This scholarship will be based on financial need as well as academic performance.
- ❖ **JIM & VELDENE KENRECK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to an incoming freshman who graduated from Hardin County High School. They should be enrolled at Southeastern Illinois College full time. The student should have an overall GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale and demonstrate financial need, but is not required.
- ❖ **KRIS KILMER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
The student applicant is to be an incoming freshman and graduate from Gallatin County High School.
- ❖ **MADDOX FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is awarded to an incoming freshman student based on academic performance and financial need.
- ❖ **JUNE RICE MALAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is awarded to a student with interest in math and science and demonstration of high academic standards.
- ❖ **MASON DE MINGS SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to an incoming freshman who graduated from Galatia High School.
- ❖ **WARREN J. & DOROTHY MEYER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a Norris City-Omaha-Enfield High School student that demonstrates an interest and talent in music.
- ❖ **CONNIE MILLER HARRISBURG TOWNSHIP CLASS OF 1961 SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a Harrisburg High School student who demonstrates the characteristics of good citizenship and is majoring in technology or engineering.

- ❖ **EARL P. MINGS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
Earl spent his life as a rural Galatia/Raleigh resident and wanted to help students, who also reside in Saline County, continue their education. This scholarship will be awarded based on consideration of career goals, financial need, and other criteria, with preference given to Galatia High School graduates.
- ❖ **FAYE MITCHELL MEMORIAL**
A scholarship is awarded to an Education Major with financial need, along with good academic standing.
- ❖ **EUGENE & CALLIE WALDEN MORRIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is to be awarded to a student working towards an Associate Degree in Arts, Science, or Liberal Arts that will transfer to a university to pursue a teaching degree or administrative education degree. The applicant should demonstrate high academic performance.
- ❖ **VIRGIL H. MOTSINGER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to an applicant that is an incoming freshman, and a resident of Saline County with a financial need.
- ❖ **GLENN MUCKLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship to be awarded to a student enrolled in a business related program. Recipient must reside in Saline County, preference given to graduate of Eldorado High School.
- ❖ **CATHERINE OLDHAM SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a student who has a C or better GPA, demonstrates EXTREME financial need, and must reside within the Southeastern Illinois College district.
- ❖ **DIZ PEARSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to an enrolled incoming freshman, must be a full-time student at Southeastern Illinois College, have a 3.0-4.0 GPA, must be a United States citizen, have financial aid but it's not required and reside in the Southeastern Illinois College District.
- ❖ **VALERA PETERSON SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in the nursing program.
- ❖ **SAM PORTER SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is awarded to one freshman and one sophomore student that have an interest in chemistry and high academic achievement.
- ❖ **WARREN & NOVETA KING-PRIEST SCHOLARSHIP**
The award will be given to a student who will be working towards a baccalaureate transfer degree where student plans to pursue a teaching degree or any educational degree and demonstrating high academic performance.
- ❖ **RICE-MURPHY SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship is awarded to an incoming freshman enrolled fulltime in either Humanities or Career and Technical Education Programs at Southeastern Illinois College. This student must have a 3.0-4.0 GPA, must be a United States citizen, and reside in the Southeastern Illinois College District.

- ❖ **LELA FRANCES “FRANNIE” ROBERTS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to an enrolled incoming freshman majoring in cosmetology. This student must demonstrate characteristics of good citizenship and reside in the Southeastern Illinois College District.
- ❖ **ROSICLARE CHAPTER #971 ORDER OF EASTERN STAR SCHOLARSHIP**
The amount of scholarship will be determined at the time of the award. The scholarship is available to a Hardin County High School graduate that must have completed a minimum of 30 hours of credit at SIC and be of sophomore standing. One-half of the scholarship will be awarded at the beginning of the recipient’s 3rd semester and the remaining one-half to be awarded at the beginning of the recipient’s 4th semester.
- ❖ **SARC SCHOLARSHIP**
This award is given to two sophomores at SIC that is enrolled as an education major specializing in providing service to the cognitively disabled.
- ❖ **JAMES R. TISON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to an incoming freshman pursuing an Engineering Degree, must be a full-time Southeastern Illinois College student, have a GPA of 3.0- 4.0 in High School, student financial aid are needed but not required, he/she must have attended high school or equivalent in the Southeastern Illinois College district, must be a Saline County Resident.
- ❖ **DR. WARREN TUTTLE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship will be awarded to a second year nursing student at SIC, must be enrolled full time, have an overall 3.5 GPA, a United States citizen, demonstrate financial need, but not required, and must be a resident of the Southeastern Illinois College district.
- ❖ **AUSTIN & DORIS WELCH MEMORIAL ART SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship award is given to a student with an interest in art and high academic achievement.
- ❖ **G.B. & ANNE WILEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**
The recipient shall be a recent graduate of Harrisburg High School, enrolled full-time in the college’s Pre-Engineering A.S. Degree Program and demonstrate high academic performance.
- ❖ **ALUMNI & FRIENDS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship awarded to an incoming freshman who demonstrates academic excellence.
- ❖ **LAW ENFORCEMENT’S FUTURE SCHOLARSHIP**
A scholarship awarded to an incoming freshman majoring in Law Enforcement/Criminal Justice.
