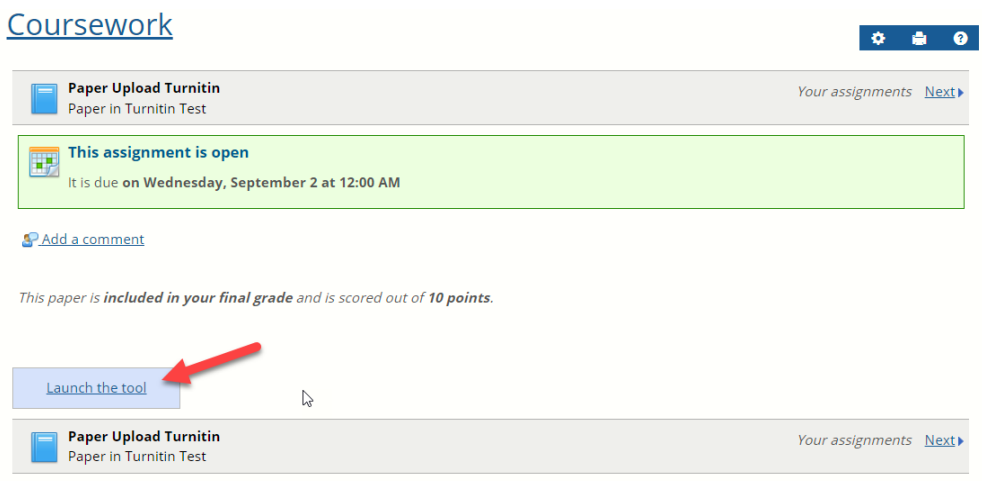

Turnitin submission guide:

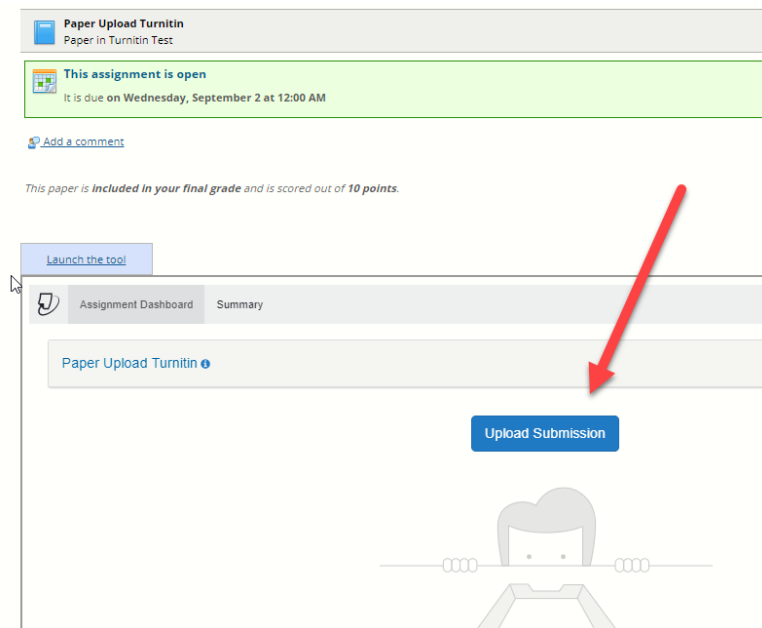
When you have an assignment that requires you to submit your paper to Turnitin, you will notice that when you click on it, there is no option to upload it. Please see the information below and or visit an example of the process here:

First you must:

- Click on "Launch the Tool"

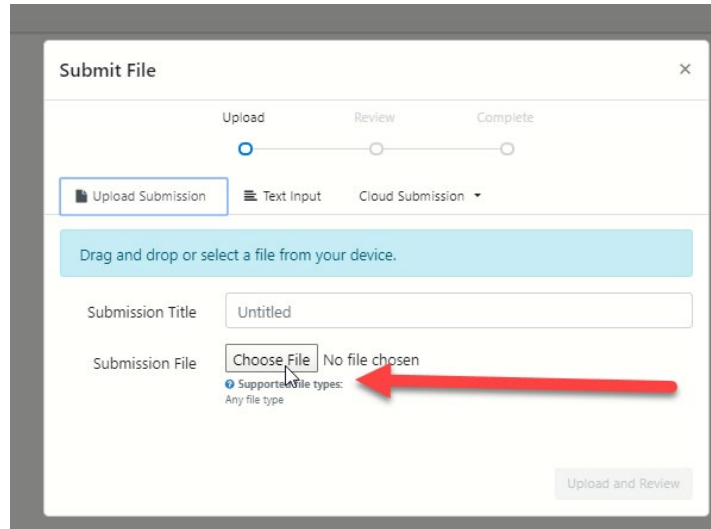


- Then Click on "Upload Submission"

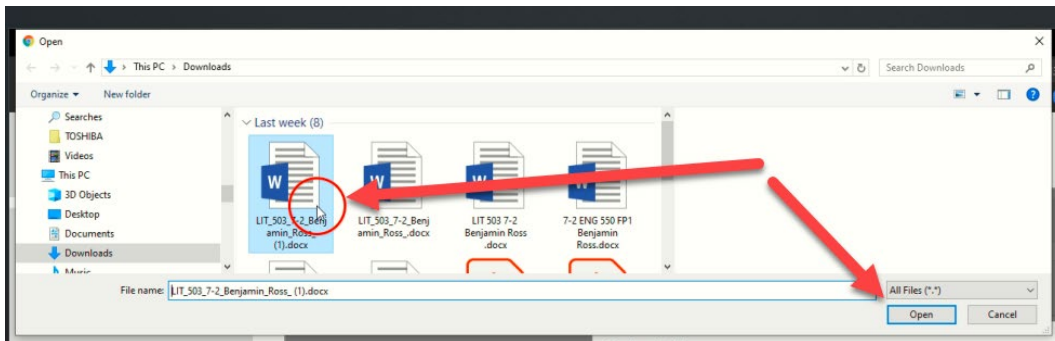

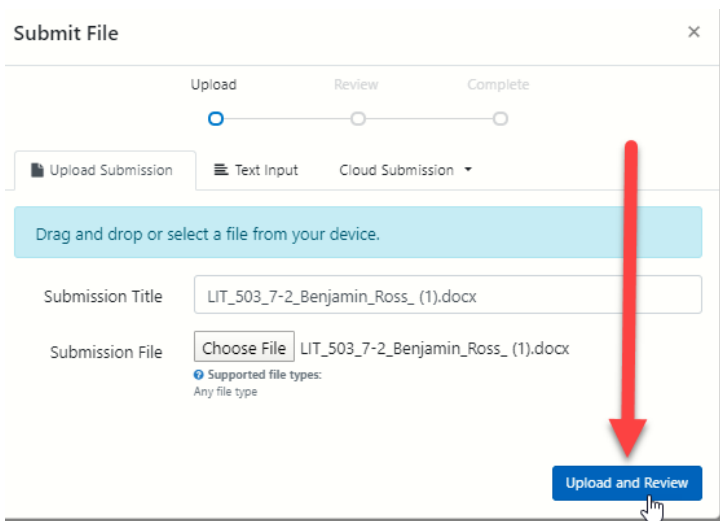
- Click on "Choose File"



- "Select your file", click "Open"

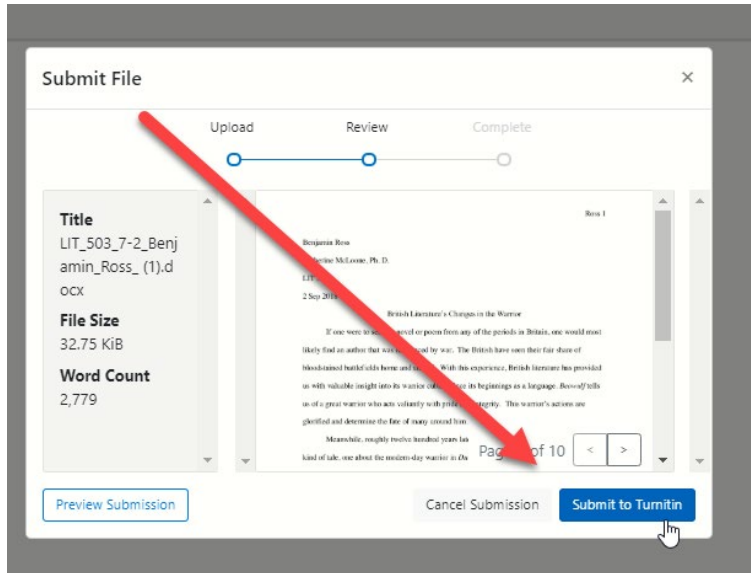


- Then click on "Upload and Review."



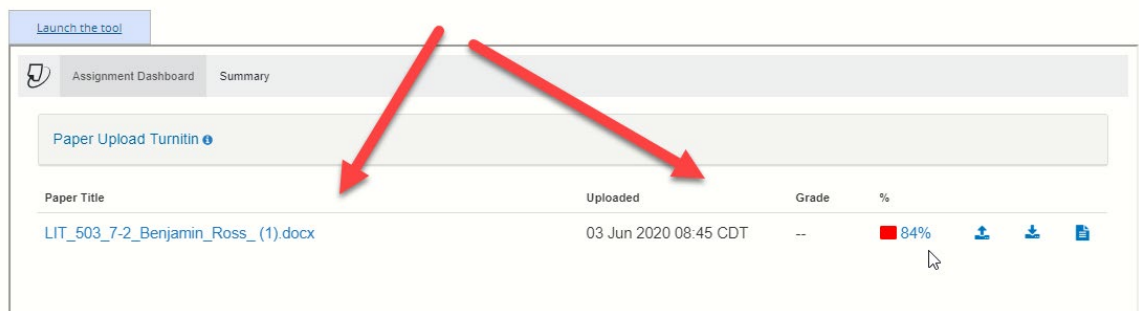
Quick Guide for Students submitting an assignment to Turnitin

- Afterward, click on "Submit to Turnitin" to complete the process.



When you are done, you will see a page similar to the below image. The similarity index report that checks for plagiarism can take anywhere from seconds to much longer. This depends on the number of students using the service and the length of the paper. Refresh or revisit the submitted assignment later if that is the case.
