To provide a wide range of student support services which reinforce the students' academic, career, and personal development.

To provide a general education program which creates a foundation for further study and enlightened citizenship.

To provide the first two (2) years of a baccalaureate degree program in the Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degrees which will enable students to transfer to a four-year institution.

To provide vocational and technical programs and courses designed to prepare students for career entry, position upgrade, and career advancement.

To provide developmental and remedial courses, programs and support services for students with academic deficiencies.

To provide educational opportunities, courses and programs in adult basic education and adult secondary education.

To provide educational and social opportunities for students to better understand the diversity of cultures and peoples in the local, national and global communities.

To provide continuing education and life-long learning opportunities for students and constituents to meet individual, cultural and leisure-time interests.

To work cooperatively with educational institutions, businesses, industries, health organizations, governmental agencies, and other community entities to provide programs and services designed to promote economic health and development of the region.

To provide cultural, recreational, and general interest events which enrich and enhance the lives of students and other residents of the community.
