American Society of Professional Estimators 2022 Scholarship Application

Once again it is time to call for applications for a scholarship award from our Chapter. The following eligibility requirements and information should be reviewed and applications made accordingly.

2022 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES

- A. One scholarship in the amount of **<u>\$1,000</u>** dollars along with a **one year free** membership to ASPE will be awarded.
- B. Applications must be received no later than: <u>5:00 pm on Wednesday February 9, 2022.</u>
- C. Scholarship will be awarded during the ASPE Chapter 19 monthly meeting scheduled for 7:30 am, on February 18, 2022 held in the city of St. Louis, location TBD. Scholarship Recipient must be present at this meeting to accept the award and will be presented a check at this time. If recipient is not available to attend this meeting, ASPE may waive this requirement or reserve the right to award the scholarship to another qualified candidate. Winner will be notified by or on February 11, 2022. ASPE Chapter 19 will cover the cost of the breakfast for the winner and a guest.
- D. Applicant shall be currently enrolled in a undergraduate program (see Paragraph E below) in an accredited Junior College or University within the United States and shall have completed a <u>minimum of 30 hours to date</u>. Applicant shall be a full-time (minimum of 12 hours per semester) or part-time (minimum of 9 hours per semester) student.
- E. Applicant must be pursuing courses of study leading to a degree related to Construction. Construction Management, Architecture, Civil/Electrical/Mechanical and Industrial Engineering are examples of some of the degree programs that would apply.
- F. Scholarship recipient will be selected based on the following criteria; Applicant's academic performance (45%) Extracurricular activities, including letters of recommendation (30%) Essay relating to applicant's future career goals (25%)

Applicants shall furnish along with their application, the following information:

Copy of College transcript. Letters of recommendation. History of employment, involvement in clubs, organizations, community activities, etc. Career goal essay

Good luck in your endeavors in achieving this scholarship! Remember, all applications must be <u>received</u> by 5:00 p.m. on 2/9/2022 to be eligible. All applications received after this date will <u>not</u> be considered.


