## GOVT 121 AMERICAN GOVERNMENT (3 credit, 3 lecture, 0 lab)

IAI S5 900

Historical development and organization of national, state, and local governments; the Federal system, national and state constitutions.

## GOVT 226 INTRO. TO INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS (3 credit, 3 lecture, 0 lab)

IAI S5 904

Study of international relations with emphasis on contemporary international problems and relations. Includes analysis of international behavior, international law, foreign policy, causes of conflicts, and potential solutions.

## GOVT 260 POLITICS IN STATES AND COMMUNITIES (3 credit, 3 lecture, 0 lab)

Historical development and organization of state government with an emphasis on the Illinois General Assembly and state constitutions. This course may be offered for variable credit and may be repeated three times.

## GOVT 261 FEDERAL AND NATIONAL POLITICS (3 credit, 3 lecture, 0 lab)

An hands on interdisciplinary study of politics at the national level. Study will be through lecture, discussions, guided study, and a trip to our Nation's Capitol. **PRE-REQUISITE:** Permission of instructor required.
