Accountability and Transparency Website Reporting Requirements – January - March 2022

Note: This is the final quarterly posting. It covers all remaining HEERF fund expenditures for Student Portion funds.

The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA Act) and the American Rescue Plan Act (ARP Act) provides emergency funds for students financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Accordingly, the following information must appear in a format and location that is easily accessible to the public. This information must also be updated no later than 10 days after the end of each calendar quarter (September 30, December 31, March 31, and June 30) thereafter, unless the Secretary specifies an alternative method of reporting:

An acknowledgement that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

Southeastern Illinois College acknowledges that the institution signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement on 4/21/20 under the CARES Act. This signed agreement carries through to the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs. The institution provides assurance that the College has used, or intends to use the applicable amount of the funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students. No funds will be received under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(4) programs as these are for proprietary schools.
