## SPAN 111 Conversational Spanish (3 credit, 3 lecture, 0 lab)

Basic application of the Spanish language for those individuals needing basic communication skills. Use of a basic vocabulary and simple, active conversation. Variable credit and repeatable three times.

SPAN 121 Elementary Spanish (4 credit, 3 lecture, 2 lab)
An introduction to Spanish with the use of simple, active conversation; reading and structural analysis of the language with stress of accent and correct pronunciation.

## SPAN 122 Elementary Spanish II (4 credit, 3 lecture, 2 lab)

A continuation of SPAN 121 with an intensive and analytical approach to the Spanish language by means of conversations, cultural readings, grammar and simple composition. Pre-Requisite: SPAN 121 or one year of high school Spanish.

SPAN 221 Intermediate Composition Reading I (4 credit, 3 lecture, 2 lab)
Grammar composition, oral practice, and selected readings of Spanish authors. Pre-Requisite: SPAN 122 or two years of high school Spanish.

SPAN 222 Intermediate Composition Reading II (4 credit, 3 lecture, 2 lab)
A continuation of SPAN 221. Pre-Requisite: SPAN 221.
