POSITION SUMMARY: This is a full-time, tenure-track position teaching Class A CDL truck driving courses at both the main campus and off-campus locations. Teaching load includes classroom and lab instruction, preparation, and other duties as assigned.

ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provides instruction for Class A CDL licensure;
- Assists students in completing CDL temporary permits and licensure, as part of the class instruction;
- Oversees maintenance of equipment specific to the instructional needs of the program;
- Oversees and maintain all records for equipment specific to the instructional needs of the program.
- Keeps current with all state and federal regulations in relation to truck driving and CDL licensure.
- Determines the instructional needs of the program, including textbooks, instructional recordings, technology, equipment, etc.
- Assists the Associate Dean and/or Division Chair with scheduling of classes within the academic year.
- Assists the Associate Dean and/or Division Chair with annual budgeting process for the needs of the program.
- Schedules DOT drug screening for students.
- Works with Associate Dean and/or Division Chair to develop additional truck driving and CDL related courses.
- Implements assessment activities into course instruction.
- Assists in recruitment activities, when available and as needed.
- Assists in the development and the revision of curriculum, based on state of Illinois and Department of Transportation regulations pertaining to CDL licensure;
- Attends meetings and job-related conferences as necessary;
- Completes other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

Must hold a current Class A CDL license in the state of Illinois; must have at minimum 5 years CDL driving experience with clean driving record (no tickets and/or occurrences); previous teaching or training experience preferred.

COMMUNICATION SKILLS:

Excellent organizational, written and verbal communication skills are needed to be successful in this position. Successful candidate must be able to work well with students and peers.

LANGUAGE SKILLS:

Ability to read and interpret documents, reports, statistics and journals. Ability to write reports, letters, and other documents in a professional manner is required.

MATHEMATICAL SKILLS:

Must be able to use basic mathematical concepts and statistics.

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS:

Valid Illinois Class A CDL license is needed.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:
