Who: Any woman who is a non-traditional student entering or currently in higher education with a declared major that will directly impact and improve the lives of women and children.

Applicants should be from Posey, Gibson, Dubois, Vanderburgh or Warrick counties in Indiana or Henderson County in Kentucky.

What: Two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each.

When: The application is due April 30, 2024.

Why: We are looking to reward deserving women in the Tri-State area who have contributed to their community and who have a desire to obtain a degree.

Application instructions/preparation:

Basic Information Needed:

- Personal Information; Contact info, email, date of birth.
- High School Name and Graduation Year
- College or University Name that you are attending or plan to attend.
- Name of Degree you are seeking.
- How did you hear about the scholarship?
- Current Employer Information

Documentation Needed:

- High School or Current Transcripts (please attach file to online application)

Essay Section:

It is advised to prepare your answers to the following questions prior to completing the online application. It may be best to do this on a blank word document and then copy and paste your answers into the online form. Answers must be less than 350 words.

- Why did you choose your major?
- What are your career objectives and how will they benefit women and children?
- Briefly describe how you have positively impacted the community in which you live. (Please list activities, awards, and honors.)
- Do you have a financial need? Please explain.
- Briefly discuss any other factors about yourself that you would like us to consider in this process.

Each section must be completed in its entirety. Applicants cannot go back to work on a section and complete it later.

Applications are due April 30, 2024.
