DEPENDENT STUDENTS

- DD214 or other official military documentation showing parent(s) Illinois residency;
- Valid Illinois driver's license, identification card, auto registration, or voter's registration card issued before **August 19, 2023**; or
- Utility or rent bills, property tax bill, or residential lease in the parent's name dated before **August 19, 2023**.

INDEPENDENT STUDENTS

If you were not required to supply your parent(s) information on the FAFSA, you are an independent student. In order to qualify for a MAP grant for the 2024-2025 year, the Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) requires that the student be an Illinois resident. You must provide a copy of one of the following documents:

- Signed and dated 2022 federal or Illinois income tax return or W-2;
- Statement of benefits history from the Illinois Department of Public Aid or Social Security Administration showing the student received benefits for the entire 2022 period;
- Current Illinois high school or Illinois college transcript;
- DD214 or other official military documentation showing the student's Illinois residency;
- Valid Illinois driver's license, identification card, auto registration, or voter's registration card issued before **August 19, 2023**; or
- Utility or rent bills, property tax bill, or residential lease in the student's name dated before **August 19, 2023**.
