

Amendments to existing policy to reflect current course offerings at Southeastern Illinois College. Also consistent with 2025 Illinois Public Act 104-0043: Educational Credit for Firefighter Experience Act, this establishes a policy for awarding academic credit for firefighter training.

Correctional

Any individual who has successfully completed the Illinois Department of Corrections Correctional Officers Training Academy pre-service training program or the Federal Bureau of Prisons Training Academy Program, upon application and official documentation will be eligible to receive credit in the following courses:

Introduction to Corrections

CRJ 213 3 semester hours

Internship

CRJ 216 3 semester hours

Police

Any individual who has successfully completed the Police Training Institute Program, upon application and official documentation will be eligible to receive credit in the following courses:

Traffic Administration and Laws

CRJ 218 3 semester hours

Policing in America

CRJ 230 3 semester hours

Internship

CRJ 216 3 semester hours

Fire

Any individual who has successfully completed the Illinois Fire Service Institute (IFSI) Basic Operations Firefighter Academy (or equivalent), upon application and official documentation will be eligible to receive credit in the following courses:

Orientation to Firefighting

FIRE 115 4 semester hours

Fire Suppression Techniques

FIRE 116 4 semester hours

Loss Control

FIRE 117 4 semester hours

Additional FIRE credit may be awarded upon for other training listed on the official IFSI (or equivalent) transcript. An academic advisor will review and transcribe appropriate credit upon receipt of the official document.
